
RYSA Player Placement Policy

Evaluations can be done in various ways:

- They can be in the fall on the soccer field by qualified RYSA personnel.
- They can be by the last coach they played soccer for.
- They can be by indoor soccer session's
- Parents cannot evaluate their own kids.

Some criteria for rankings are as follows:

- Player's skill level.
- Passing, Shooting, Ball control, Game awareness, Strength, Speed, Agility.
- Players availability to be at all games, and practices.
- Players attitude on the field to encourage others, and promote team play.
- Players drive to be better, always trying to improve.
- Players future rankings may be based on past rankings.

The RYSA Evaluations Committee will decide the rankings, and team formation.

Players rankings are for the RYSA Board only, they are not to be made public or shared.

Teams shall be formed by like ability.

Teams in same age group shall have equal numbers in all divisions.

Once the teams are formed and playing, coaches can pick up more players to fill their roster.

This recruiting can be awarded to their own team.
